Call for Entries 2011 H.A.P. Art Contest

The Henderson Art Project (H.A.P.) is an annual event selecting 11 artists to exhibit their work for a 2 year placement on Henderson Avenue, Dallas 75206. After the 2 year period, art will be returned to the artists. The 7 sculptures and 4 paintings will be selected. Each artist selected will be awarded an \$800 stipend and become finalists for a citywide vote. The citywide People's Choice prize money is First \$3,000, Second \$2,000, and Third \$1,000.

Visit www.hendersonartproject.com to view proposed art placement sites. Artists are encouraged to suggest the ideal location for their work; however final placements will be decided by Henderson Art Project selection committee.

2D artwork

4 paintings will be selected to be placed on H.A.P. easels. Wood canvas, provided by H.A.P. is 4' x 6' dimensions. An exterior paint is required and a clear coating will be applied afterward to further protect the art.

3D artwork

7 pieces of sculpture will be selected and placed on the Henderson Avenue.

Actual work completed or conceptual renderings are accepted. All work must be completed and installed by March 23rd.

In an effort to promote the artists, we post links to your work on the H.A.P. web page. Please provide an image of yourself and link to your work. Information can be sent to scott@hendersonartproject.com. As soon as you know you'll submit an application, forward your contact information, so we can post your contact information as soon as possible. We'd like to do this as soon as possible!

Art work requirements:

- Sculptors are responsible for installations
- 4x6 wooden canvas will be provided and delivered to painters to complete
- Pedestals and art pads are the responsibility of 3D artists
- Art work must be safe for people to touch and secured safely among heavy foot traffic
- Art work is placed outdoors, on a public street therefore must be durable, safe, and secured
- Art must be completed and installed by March 23, 2010
- Art work insurance is the responsibility of participating artists

Note: All artists will receive a H.A.P. t-shirt. T-shirts will be picked up at the official H.A.P. headquarters.

Submission requirements:

1. \$25 entry fee (Non-refundable check or money order payable to Support the Arts.)
2. Short statement about art to be placed on Henderson Avenue. Less than 300 words saved as a Word document. Save document with artist's name. e.g.: Trentartapp1.doc
2. 3 images of art per submission (limit 3 submissions)
4. Concept drawings are accepted, but art work must be completed and installed by March 19, 2010. Artists must demonstrate an ability to complete any submitted concepts.
5. Download application form, type information, save document and submit as attachment and email to scott@hendersonartproject.com. Save document with artist's name. e.g. Trentartapp2.doc

Photos of accepted applicant's artwork become the property of the Henderson Art Project. Images may be displayed on marketing materials and web site. Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance or placement of art. H.A.P. officials reserve the right to select or reject submitted art.
